PART. I
PRELIMINARY

- Citation 1. These Tariffs may be cited as the Copyright and Neighbouring Rights (Licensing of Reproduction and Rental Rights) Tariffs, 2025 and shall come into operation on the date of publication.
- Interpretation 2. In these Tariffs, unless the context otherwise requires: -
"Author" means a natural person who creates a work
"Act" means a Copyright and Neighbouring Rights Act.
"Copyright Administrator" means the head of the Office appointed as such in terms of the Act at COSOTA.
"Copyrighted Work" Means a work whose sole legal rights to hire, reproduce, print, publish, perform film or record a literally or artistic or Musical work is protected.
"Copying centre" Means a place where an imitation or reproduction of an original literary works are done.
"COSOTA" means the Copyright Office.
"Library" means a place in which literary and artistic materials, such as books, periodicals, newspapers, pamphlets, prints, records, and tapes, are kept for reading, reference, or lending.
"License" means a license issued under tariff 5(1).
"Literary work" Means a work of a writer; anything expressed in letters of the alphabet (especially when considered from the point of view of style and effect).
"Mass reproduction" means reproduction of work beyond normal exploitation or free use of an author's work through photocopying and such other similar means of reproductions including printouts from digital processes, where such reproduction is done in excess of 100 pages per person per year;

"Rental Right" means a right, whether by renting or hire, afforded in terms of these Tariffs to use one's literary work in return for payments;

"Reproduction" means photocopying and such similar reproductions of a copyrighted work, and includes printouts from digital processes";

"Reproduction right" means a right of reproduction of copyrighted work";

"Rental" means a lease for a fee for a short period of time of a copyrighted work.

"Society" is the Reproduction Rights Society of Tanzania (TANRRS) licensed under Section 57 of the Copyright and Neighbouring Rights Act of 1999

PART. II

APPLICATION FOR REPRODUCTION AND RENTAL OF LITERARY, ARTISTIC WORKS LICENCE

Reproduction and hire of copyrighted works 3. (1) Save as provided in sections 9, 12 and 15 of the Act, a person shall not rent, hire or undertake mass reproduction of literary or copyrighted work unless that person has a valid license issued by the Society."

(2) Any person who contravenes the provisions of sub-regulation (1) commits an offence and shall, on conviction, be liable to;

(a) a fine of not exceeding five million shillings or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three years or to both, for the first offence if the infringement was on a commercial basis

(b) a fine not exceeding ten million shillings or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding five years or both, for each subsequent offence if the infringement was on a commercial basis.

Application of license for reproduction and hire of copyrighted works 4. Any application of license for reproduction of literary Works or shall be:

(a) made to the Society in the form set out in Part I of the First Schedule to these Tariffs:

(b) Accompanied with the form set out in part IV

(c) Upon payment of a fee prescribed by the Society

Issue of License	<p>5. (1). Within fifteen days upon receipt of an application for reproduction of Copyrighted works from the applicant, the Society shall issue a license in the form set out in Part II of the First Schedule to these Regulation.</p> <p>(2). The Licence issued under sub-regulation (1) shall be subject to-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">(a) conditions specified in the licensing contract set out in Part III of the First Schedule to these Tariffs;(b) The payment of the royalties corresponding to the appropriate tariff classification specified in the Second Schedule to these Tariffs.
Refusal to issue License	<p>6. Where the society refused to issue license, shall within fourteen days from the date of decision communicate in writing the reasons of such refusal to the applicant</p>
Validity of a License	<p>7. The license shall be valid only for the purpose in respect of which it has been issued and for the period, and with respect to the premises, specified thereon.</p>
License to be displayed	<p>8. The licensee shall display the license in a prominent and visible position at or near the main entrance to the premises at which the reproduction or rental is taking place.</p>
Distribution	<p>9. The Society shall, out of the collected fees and in accordance with its own procedures, pay to the entitled fees to the rights holders or to the class of rights holders as set out in the Third Schedule.</p>
Appeals	<p>10. (1) Subject to sub regulation (2), an applicant under this Act who is dissatisfied by any condition of a license or aggrieved by any decision of the Society on a refusal to issues a license, may, prior to undersigning or consenting to any conditions, or, as the case may be, within fourteen days from the date of receipt of the decision of the Society, appeal in writing to the Copyright Administrator, and the Copyright Administrator shall within 45 days make his determination:</p>

(2) An appeal laid before the Copyright Administrator shall be stated in a chronological manner supported by evidenced and reliefs sought.

(3) The Copyright Administrator may, on consideration of the appeal, confirm, vary or rescind the decision of the Society and inform the Appellant of his decision with reasons.

Penalty for failure to pay fees 11. The person who failed to pay license fees in time shall, in addition to the fees payable under these Tariffs, pay a late payment fees specified in the Second Schedule.

Validity of acts 12. Anything done by the Society in respect of reproduction and rental before, during or after coming into force of these Tariffs which is capable of being done by the Society under these Tariffs shall be deemed to have been done under the Copyright Act.

Adjustments of fees` 13. (1) The fees stated in the Second Schedule to these Tariffs may be revised by the Copyright Administrator on the advice of the Society
(2) The annual license fees shall be based on the tariffs classification provided in the Second Schedule of these Tariffs.

Classification of Tariffs 14. For the purpose of determination of royalties on mass reproduction in terms of these Tariffs, tariffs shall be classified as follows:
(a) Tariff **UNI** Universities: Public and Private
(b) Tariff **COL** Colleges; both public and private
(c) Tariff **SEC** Secondary schools classified into public, private, international and religious schools.
(d) Tariff **PRI** primary schools classified into public, private, international and special schools.
(e) Tariff **ORG** Reproduction in organizations and institutions whether public, private, research, international or religious
(f) Tariff **RPC** payable for reproduction in photocopying centres; and
(g) Tariff **AOB** payable for reproduction by any other establishments determined by the society in so far as.

PART. III
PROCEDURE, SUSPENSION AND
REVOCAION OF A LICENSE

Procedure for
serving a default
notice

15 - (1) Where an applicant contravenes the terms and conditions of which a license was issued, the society shall serve on the applicant a default notice in writing specifying the nature of default and possible legal sanctions.

(2) Upon receipt of default notice, the applicant shall make representation in writing to the society within fourteen days from the date of notice regarding a remedy or rectification of the default.

Failure to remedy
or rectify the
default

16. (1) Where the licensee fails to remedy or rectify the default within the time specified in the default notice or fails to make a satisfactory representation, the Society shall suspend or revoke the license as the case may be.

(2) Notwithstanding the provision of sub regulation (i) where the licensee was issued with the Revocation Notice requiring him to stop operation and continues with operation the Society shall be at the liberty to seize the equipments used for reproduction by the licensee.

Provided that the seizure shall be for such reasonable period as may be necessary to give effect the reporting and transfer of the property to the custody of the police and the institution of suit summarily for contravention under these Tariffs and the Act:

Provided further than the procedure for seizure, by police officers of the permissible rank and in terms of the applicable written laws, shall apply mutatis-mutandis to seizure under these tariffs.

Suspension or
revocation of a
license

17. -(1) Where the Society suspends or revokes a license it shall provide reasons for such revocation or suspension to the licensee

(2) Where a license is revoked or suspended under these Tariffs, the licensee after being served with the notice of revocation or suspension as the case may be shall, immediately cease operations and immediately surrender the license to the society.

(3) In case of suspension the society shall return the license to the applicant after expiry of suspension

period and fulfilment of other requirements as shall be stipulated in the suspension notice period.

PART. IV
GENERAL PROVISIONS

Power to
undertake
inspection

18. (1) An officer of the Society, a Police officer or an agent may undertake an inspection to any person/establishment with a view to ascertaining whether or not the provisions of these Tariffs are being complied with.

Offences and
Penalty

19. (1) Any person who contravenes the provisions of these Tariffs commits an offence and on conviction is liable to the punishment as stipulated under Section 45, 47 and 48 of the Act.

(2) In addition or in the alternative to a fine, the offender may have the offending copies and equipments impounded and held in the custody of the society till when the owner complies with these Tariffs.

THIRD SCHEDULE

(Made under Tariff 9) DISTRIBUTION RULES

1. RIGHTS:

These distribution rules relate to the following rights assigned to the Reproduction Rights Society of Tanzania

- (a) The Copyrights of national and foreign authors of literary works for the following types of uses:

- Reproduction
- Rental or hire

In case where a society tariff applies to both categories of rights hereinbefore mentioned the income from royalties based on such tariff shall be distributed in the following manner:

- 50% for the national and foreign authors of artistic, musical, literary and dramatic works;
- 50% for the national and foreign publishers of artistic, musical, literary and dramatic works.

2. RIGHTS OF AUTHORS OF COPYRIGHTED LITERARY WORKS

- (a) Distribution classes

All royalties due to the national and foreign authors of works shall be deemed to come from one of the following two distribution classes.

Class 1. Reproduction by way of photocopying, etc.;

Class 2. Rental or hiring in educational institutions and libraries both commercial and non-commercial.

- (i) *Attribution of the royalties to the different distribution classes*

The royalties collected on the basis of these tariffs shall be attributed to the distribution classes as follows:-

Class 1 Tariff UNI Universities: Public and Private

Tariff COL Colleges; both public and private

Tariff SEC secondary schools classified into public, private, international and religious schools.

Tariff PRI primary schools classified into public, private, international and special schools.

Tariff ORG reproduction in organizations and institutions

Tariff RPC reproduction in photocopying centres

Tariff AOB reproduction in any other establishments.

Class 2 Tariff UNI
Tariff COL Tariff
SEC Tariff PRI
Tariff LIB

(B) Specific rules for the different distribution classes

(i) **Class 1**

The distribution shall correspond with the actual reproduction for each work per pages estimated.

3. DEDUCTION OF COSTS OF ADMINISTRATION, ETC

Before attributing the royalties to the different rights holders a percentage to cover administration costs of society shall be deducted. This percentage shall be the same for all the royalties collected.

The percentage of the deduction shall correspond with the effective costs of administration of society without aiming at accumulating a reserve or making profit but it shall NOT exceed 30% of the gross royalty collections.

- (a) Money for foreign societies not signatory with society shall be in reserve funds for 3 years after which if not distributed to owners may be used to be distributed to national rights holders one month after the lapse of three years.
- (b) Royalties not distributed shall be in reserve funds for 3 years after which if not distributed to owners may be used to be distributed to national rights holders one month after the lapse of three years.

4. ROYALTIES RECEIVED FROM FOREIGN SISTER SOCIETIES

Royalties received from foreign sister societies shall be paid as soon as possible to the deserving members of Society, after deduction of a handling charge of 5% designed to cover administration costs of society.

These tariffs are approved to be applied in respect of reprographic and similar reproduction of literary works falling under TANRR's Repertoire, in accordance with the Copyright and Neighboring Rights Act No. 7/1999 (CAP 218 RE of 2023) and The Copyright and Neighbouring Rights (Licensing of Reproduction and Rental Rights) Regulations, 2014 and its amendment of 2018.

These tariffs shall remain in effect until such time as revised tariffs are submitted to and approved by COSOTA.
